ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR Master in Public Health

Doctors (degree holders in Medicine/ Dentistry) with at least 2nd division.

Medical staff other than above (i.e doctors) including paramedical, nursing, and other auxiliary staff employed in management positions in the following organizations.

- a. Govt. /autonomous organization
- b. National/international NGOs

Masters/Postgraduate/ Diploma/Bachelor's degree in life sciences, at least 2nd division, employed in the above positions and having qualifications in area related to Health, Pharmacy, Nutrition, Public administration, Business Administration, Economics, Sociology, Mass Communications, Journalism, social work with a at least 3 years' experience.

In case of vacant seats, inexperienced candidates may also be considered

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General Instructions

1. Qualifying the written Test and appearance for the Interview are compulsory requirements for Admission.
2. Only those students who qualify the written test shall be eligible to appear for the Interview.
3. The List of the candidates to appear for the Interview shall be displayed on the Institute's Notice Board as well as on Official Website; www.imsciences.edu.pk.

4. Entrance Slip will be generated in online apply portal for all the Candidates appearing in the Test. No one will be allowed to enter the Examination Hall/Premises without the Entrance Slip.

Note: Applicants having a valid NTS NAT score for MPH Program will not be required to appear in the test, however they can take the IMSciences Entrance Test to improve their score.

6. Take Care of your entrance slip. In case you misplace your entrance slip, you can get its duplicate copy from the office of IMS on payment of Rs.500/.
7. All Original Documents shall be verified at the time of Admission. Students are required only to attach their Bachelors/Masters or equivalent qualification Provisional Certificate, DMCs and three passport size photographs. Please write your name and father's name at the back of photographs. Hard documents will be accepted after admission interviews.
8. The Documents once submitted with Admission forms shall not be returned.
9. No separate call letters are issued to the candidates for Test and Interview in (Master Program). All Information regarding Admission shall be displayed on the Institute's Notice Board and/or Official Website.
10. Admission to MBA (Banking and Finance) is on all Pakistan basis. The Candidate applying for Admission to the said Program will be kept well informed about the admission schedule in time.

12. Hostel accommodation may be provided to the candidates, subject to the availability of seats.

7. The test is divided into 5 parts. The Instructions for each part is given on the question paper. Please follow the Instructions carefully and take care of time.

9. Total duration of the test is 90 Minutes.
10. All the questions in the Entry Test are MCQ's and they are checked thoroughly. However, if someone is interested in rechecking, the candidate shall apply for the same within three days of the declaration of the test result. The fee for rechecking of the paper is Rs.500.
